- Must have participated in at least one area of the Fine Arts programs at TRA during their high school tenure.

- Two written letters of recommendation from someone other than family or the Fine Arts faculty at TRA.
- Resume of accomplishments and activities in the area of Fine Arts for which you are applying for a scholarship.
- Approval by Faculty Signature required on Application Form

- 250-300 word essay answering the question: How has participating in the Fine Arts enriched your High School years and how will it influence your future?
